Mr. AVULA SAMBASIVA RAO

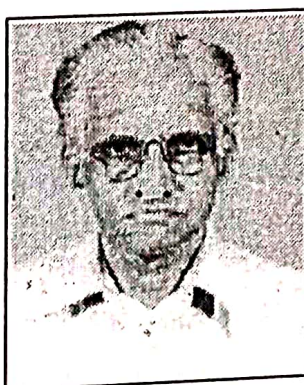
Retired Chief Justice, A.P.
